Under the provision of the Act of Congress “To promote the Education of the Blind,” enacted March 3, 1879 (20 Stat. 467), as amended, all legally blind students and adults of less than college level are eligible to receive educational materials from the American Printing House for the Blind (APH) in Louisville, Kentucky. The Act provides a per capita allocation designated for the purpose of providing materials for each student registered with APH. The Federal Program for Maryland is maintained and administered through the Statewide Instructional Resource Center (IRC), located at The Maryland School for the Blind.
