**CONSENT FOR USE OF THE PAPOOSE  
FOR MEDICAL PROCEDURES  
Health Center - School Year 2011-2012**

The “papoose” is a canvas covered board with Velcro straps wrapped around a child. It is fairly commonly used in pediatric medical settings to insure the safety of caregivers and patients during medical procedures.

Given that we are a school health center and, therefore, usually do not have parents/ guardians present, we would like permission to use the papoose for your child, when needed, for drawing blood or for exams, such as looking in ears.
